Pride 10k

"There was quite a GCR contingent at the Burnham Beeches Half and 10k. The races, brilliantly organised by Burnham Joggers, start and finish at Caldicott School and take in a mix of closed roads and hard surfaced woodland paths through the cool shade of the Burnham Beeches ancient woodland in South Bucks. The 10k race is one undulating lap, and the half marathon is two (although I thought there were more hills in the second lap, how could that be?).

"There is the opportunity to dive into the school pool after the race, but on a pleasantly cool day this was perhaps less tempting than it would have been in warmer temperatures." BECCA HAYDEN ran a new PB of 1:3:39 and was 6th lady. REBECCA BARDEN ran a new PB of 1:41:36, followed by KATY HEALY, ANN HAYDEN, ANNE HENSON, and JULY KEAN.

Taking part in the 10k distance were WAYNE AYLOTT, JUSTIN KEAN and Justin and July's son, new member RYAN KEAN.


