# Barden takes on Berlin Marathon Gilbert VM70 debut

#### **Berlin Marathon**

REBECCA BARDEN made Berlin her 10<sup>th</sup> marathon this weekend and her third of the six World Marathon Majors. The course sets off through the Tiergaten and past the Berlin

Victory Column and then the finish runners go through the iconic Brandenburg Gates. Rebecca reported that it was very warm and humid this morning and even though she set of too fast , she did enough to meet qualifying standards completing the course in 3hrs 40mins and 39secs.

Although not a GCR a mention must go to ELIUD KIPCHOGE who ran an incredible new world record in the men's race, his time of 2hrs 01mins and 39secs smashed Dennis Kimetto's 2014 record, also set in Berlin, of 2hrs 02mins 57secs.



#### **Purbeck Marathon**

NICHOLAS GENEVER ventured to Dorset this weekend to participate in the Purbeck Marathon, a trail marathon incorporating the Jurassic coast and Purbeck hills. The route began at Swanage along the coastal path to the Lulworth firing ranges. Then back along the ridge of the Purbeck Hill passing Corfe Castle. Nicolas completed the 26.8 mile course in 4:40:30 and the total ascent was 870m.

#### **Royston Harvest Trail**

A number of Garden City Runners took on the hills of Royston to complete the Harvest Trail. Official timings have not yet been release but a number of GCR's reported that course to be challenging but enjoyable. RICHARD DARLEY completed the course in 2:30:20, his second half marathon in 2 weeks.

Thursday. This was Dave's is 17<sup>th</sup> Marathon event this year. The race involved running as many laps as you can within the 6 hour time limit. Each lap included 180 metres of hill running on a rough uneven stony trail. Dave completed the marathon distance in a time of 5hrs 46mins and 50secs and a total elevation of 2950ft.

Dave reports that this was his toughest marathon to date. 'The organisation, atmosphere and camaraderie in amongst the runners on the day was brilliant'. Dave recommends this event to any brave Garden City Runner challenger next year, it reignited his passion for running!
