GCRs SHOW YOU'LL NEVER STANDALONE

Affinity Water Hatfield 5K Series Race 3

The final race in the three-race Hatfield 5K Race series, organised by Garden City Runners in association with Affinity Water, took place on 3 October, and was followed by prize presentations in the sumptuous surroundings of Affinity Water's HQ. Ware Joggers carried off the men's team series prize and North Herts Road Runners the women's trophy. GCR men's team came third and the women's team scooped second place. Rising star AFEWORK ROSSOM of Herts Phoenix won all three races and took the men's individual prize for the series, with Dacorum & Tring AC's KATIE RENNIE earning gold in the women's competition. GCR's MARTHA HALL was second overall in the women's series and took the women's vets' prize for Race 3. Series bronze medallists included GCR's PAUL GUY in the MV40 category and JUSTIN HILL in the MV50s. YUKO GORDON from Fairlands Valley Spartans was the fastest age graded athlete at 92%.

Standalone 10K

October's Avery race saw a strong cohort of GCRs heading up the A1 on a beautifully sunny morning, a relief after Saturday's miserable conditions. A happy combination of perfect racing conditions, a well-organised race and plenty of friendly support around the course saw several GCRs scoring personal best times. First GCR across the line and 23rd overall was THOMAS WACKETT in a new pb of 36:49, cloisely followed by RUSSELL CASEY in 36:58 and 24th and ROB CASSERLEY in 37:04 and 28th overall. DAVE DESBOROUGH's time of 39:36 won him first place in the MV60 category. MICHAEL RUSSELL finished in 40:37 and STEVE ELLERD-ELLIOTT ran a pb of 40:39. ROB HUGHES ran in 41:08; MARK EDWARDS in 44:17; MICHAEL PAINE in a pb of 44:25; KEITH McCLELLAN in 44:59 and Chair BRAD SMITH in 45:24. First GCR lady home was HANNAH FRANK in 45:31, not a pb but over two minutes faster than her 2017 time. STEVEN EDWARDS ran in 46:07 and EMON MARTIN in 47:19. JUSTIN KEAN and JULY KEAN arrived later than planned after they stopped to help your humble editrix whose tyre had exploded on the way to the race, but their goodness was rewarded when they both ran pbs of 49:49 and 53:28 respectively. STEVE BUTTON ran in 50:49; JOHN DAVIS (The Taller) made a return to racing form in 50:53; CAROL REID was second GCR lady in 51:43, just pipping

TIM COOKE ran in 52:16; RICHARD DARLEY and HAYLEY CONNOLLY (pictured, left) crossed the line together in 54:22; MAGGIE WRIGHT finished in 56:33; MELANIE KING in 57:13; SHENA LANCASTER in 59:21; EMMA DEMPSTER in 1:00:52; TOM CASSERLEY in 1:11:32. GCR supervets DENNIS and ELEANOR DRAPER finished in 1:13:01 and 1:23:48 respectively.

Willow 10K

GCR's ADAM WADLEY and NIGEL CAVILL took part in this scenic autumnal race around the grounds of Hatfield House. Adam entered the race after being too slow to the draw and missing out on entry for the Standalone 10k, and it's a location that has special meaning for him, as it's where he and fellow GCR Felicity held their wedding reception. He reports: "It was a lovely charity event for a good cause with the added bonus for any Arsenal fans of being greeted by Bob Wilson at the finish line!" Adam very modestly didn't let on that he won the race in a time of exactly 40.00 minutes, and Nigel was fifth overall in 42:59.

Bournemouth Half and Marathon

It was a trip to the seaside for several GCRs taking part in these popular South Coast half and marathon races. In the half, PAUL GUY was first GCR and 20th overall in a time of 1:19:02, and SOFIE MARCHANT smashed her PB to finish in 1:46:18. ANDY SHADBOLT kept busy while his other half VERONICA was running the marathon, finishing the 13.1 miles in 1:57:51. Meanwhile, taking on the full 26.2 were JAMES DUNMORE, coming back from a summer of injury and a niggling ankle problem, to cross the line in 3:45:30, with



VERONICA SHADBOLT (above) just behind him in 3:46:03, and RICHARD ROBINSON in 3:55:22. CHARLOTTE JONES eschewed the lure of Avery points to tackle the Big One, finishing in 6:20:14. On hand as support crew and photographer was club stalwart Terry Fowler, himself a veteran of the Bournemouth marathon, currently recuperating from illness – hope to see you back racing soon Terry.

Oxford Half

GCR's ZOE STEPHENS travelled to the City of Dreaming Spires and ran a dream race, finishing in a storming 1:33:10.
