Ladies ride high at Stevenage Half

Eleanor's dream debut drives team to Herts County Seniors silver prize

Stevenage Half Marathon



Early calculations suggest that GCR's ladies team won the Herts County Seniors silver team prize at the weekend's Stevenage Half Marathon. Newbie ELEANOR NEWTON (1:37:42) set the pace on her first appearance for GCR, along with REBECCA BARDEN (1:44:24) and HELEN PAINE (2:00:49), who finished the course in a highly respectable time despite not feeling her best.

The race incorporated a two-lap route (one short, one longer), laden with underpasses and dreary sections, leavened with some scenic views through Fairlands Valley Park and the generous support of marshals and spectators alike. The weather was perfect, overcast at the start with a light smattering of rain and bright winter sunshine peeping

through the clouds.

Having only recently joined the club, ELEANOR was delighted with her run. "I only took up the place offered by MARTHA HALL on the afternoon before the race and was delighted with my new half marathon PB of 1:37.42 on a course which was much hillier than it looked on the elevation plan," she said.

As far as achievements were concerned, both STEVE ELLERD-ELLIOTT and MICHAEL

PAINE ran PBs (in 1:34:39 and 1:41:02 respectively) and RUSSELL CASEY finished 14th overall in an excellent 1:23:55.

"By the time I got to 20 miles, and the start of the Seven Sisters, my legs were so sore I was forced to walk the steeper sections. Nevertheless I managed to finish in 4:03:18, for a top 200 position. Thanks to NICK GENEVER for advice and for the lift home." Nick's time of 4:22:09 was reported last week.

parkrun round up

There were many outstanding achievements at this week's parkruns around the country. TOM WACKETT recorded a PB in finishing 6th at Hackney Marshes in a time of 17:28, and SEAN BOWEN achieved likewise down in Southampton, finishing in a time of 19:15. Running Westmill for the first time, PAUL GUY was a comfortable winner in 19:31. Ladies captain CHARLEE CHAPMAN was in action at Aylesbury, PBing in an excellent time of 22:42. Running the fast track at Ellenbrook Fields, NEIL HUME finished in his customary lead position, coming through the funnel in 17:11, with JACK TANN recording an excellent PB of 17:52 to finish 4th and TREVOR DAVIES PBing in 20:05. Meanwhile RICHARD SOMERSET borrowed some nuclear power at Sizewell, finishing 2nd in 20:28.
