#### Sunday XC League

Results from Fairlands Park were ratified too late for last week's newsletter (although we managed to carry photos). So we are pleased to bring them here.

Reporting on the event, Men's Club Captain, SEAN BOWEN, said: "A very strong turnout from GCR saw 36 of our men and 12 women at the third race of five in the SXCL series. Host clubs FVS and Hitchin had reluctantly decided they could no longer use their Willian course and venue, and instead improvised a three-lap route on the undulating grass of Fairlands Valley Park in Stevenage—at the south end, away from the lakes. After the Siberian Saturday, the early sunshine made for a lovely mild bright morning. Conditions underfoot varied throughout, with shady sections in the enclosure still hard and frosty, while the exposed upper section became gradually softer and wetter."

A rare appearance from student DANNY FIGG boosted the young GCR men's A-team, and he finished in a commendable 22nd. Meanwhile, young newcomer ELEANOR NEWTON made an outstanding 32nd in her first league appearance for GCR, and very new joiner BELINDA MCGINLEY finished an excellent 57th in her first race with the club.

Team GCR finished 4th overall on the day. In the table, the men lie 4th and the women 6th. "*Thanks to HELEN PAINE and MICK WISE for taking care of the GCR team results recording, and to all our supporters who came along to watch,"* summarised Sean."

# **Denys Baudry**

With strong historic links to GCR over three decades, vegan runner DENYS BAUDRY (*pictured*) recently became the first Frenchman ever to have run over 500 marathons (which makes him the French national champion with a tally of

530-plus marathons. "I am happy to have reached this landmark not so much for myself but for the vegan movement. Having been vegan for some 25 years, and 20 years veggie before that, I have been living in the UK since the early 70's and belong to the Vegan Runners," he states.

Denys, who has lived in Borehamwood for many years, has run a total of 511 marathons plus 21 ultras, and with five more marathons to run before the end of the year he hopes to finish on a grand total of 538!



## <u>parkruns</u>

As parkruns grow in popularity the GCR parkrun tourism club. masterminded by TOM WACKETT, has set Castle Park (January 5<sup>th</sup>), Gadebridge (February 2<sup>nd</sup>) and Aldenham (March 2<sup>nd</sup>) as its first confirmed dates (see *Forthcoming Events* below).

Several GCR's recorded PB's over the various parkrun courses this weekend. Highlights included PETER MEIGH, PBing at Panshanger in 21:30 and JAMES HUISH setting a best time at Burnham & Highbridge in 17:43, while PAUL GUY scored a new PB at Ellenbrook Fields, finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> in 17:43 but still failing to reel in the indomitable NEIL HUME, who won the race in 17:09. Other good performances at Ellenbrook Fields included BECKY DAY, whose time of 26:57 was a PB, while another sub-20 runner, SEAN BOWEN ran Basingstoke in 19:58. For full results <u>click here</u>.
