# Spring sunshine sees GCRs on the podium

As spring marathons hove into view, it's an ideal time to tackle an organised long training run or race. While several GCRs were at Gade Valley for the Gade Valley Harriers' eponymous and much-loved training run, six GCRs took on this undulating road race around the scenic lanes of Bedfordshire. An unexpectedly warm morning saw two GCRs, out of a total field of 870 runners, take home age group prizes, with NEIL HUME winning the MV40 trophy and coming fifth overall in a time of 1:58:48, while ANNE HENSON (left, receiving her trophy) won her age group FV65 in a sterling 3:06:21. CHRIS JONES clocked an impressive 2:16:22; REBECCA BARDEN was pleased with her time of 2:44:42; Chair BRAD SMITH ran in 2:53:00, and SALLY

LAFLIN came back from 'flu to finish in 3:16:30. Special mention to MICHAEL PAINE who

persevered with an Achilles injury before sensibly calling it a day at mile 14 in the hope of being fit for his Brighton Marathon bid in three weeks' time – get well soon Michael!

## Lea Valley Run Fest

A hearty contingent of GCRs travelled to the Lea Valley White Water Centre to compete in half marathon and 10K races, run round picturesque woodland trails. In the half marathon distance, STEVE EDWARDS finished in 1:49:12. In the 10K, MICK WISE ran in 52.09;

HELEN STAFFORD was just behind him in 52:17; CHRISTOPHER PEASE finished in 59:31; NAZ GEZER-CLARKE was delighted to run comfortably under an hour in 59:33; KAREN ATKINSON finished in 1:02:29; PETER LAPTHORNE in 1:05:16; SANDRA WISE in 1:07:38; MAUREEN STEED in 1:14:57; DAWN REDWOOD in 1:17:17, and CLAIR EMMS in 1:22:59.

### Hawkshead Hobble

Several GCRs took part in this multi-lap race, encompassing one-lap 5K and two-lap 10K distances, through rolling pastures and bluebell woods starting and finishing at the Royal Veterinary College in Potters Bar. All finishers receive medals in the form of cowbells. It was

another podium event for GCR, with ROBERT CARTWRIGHT (*below, with cowbell*) winning first male in the 5K event in a time of 28:17, and Rob's daughter EMILY HAMMOND was tenth lady in 34:10. In the 10K event, BECCA HAYDEN (*on the podium, below*) took silver for the ladies in 44:39; MAGGIE WRIGHT finished in 59:14; MELANIE KING not far behind in 59:33, and ALEXANDRA YATES ran in 1:02:33.



Becca writes "A beautiful morning for a 10k round the Hertfordshire countryside, it was so hot when we started at 10:45 am, shorts and a vet were a must!! A lovely cross country and hilly route through fields and woodlands, raising money for the Potters Bar Food Bank - such a friendly race and a lovely start to the day."

#### London Landmarks Half

GCR's RICHARD DARLEY was one of approximately 13,000 runners taking part in this closedroad half that tours some of London's most historic landmarks in Westminster and the City. Richard writes: "It was a perfect day for running around the sites of Big London Town; I've now approached The Guildhall from every angle! I was chuffed with my time of 1:58:26."

#### Falésia 5K

Husband and wife GCR legends TERRY and ELAINE FOWLER took part in this annual race in The Algarve around a hilly three lap course in very hot conditions. Both finished in a commendable 27:40. Terry reports: "There were no medals or t-shirts for this one, just a bad case of sun stroke for Elaine...." The race was run in a very speedy 15 minutes with an England female international marathon runner coming 4th in the ladies' race in 18:23, and the first lady finishing in 17:45.
