GCRs take on the UK Athletes of Outstanding Natural Briskness in action

Great Hertfordshire AONB Marathon, Half and 10K

This multi-terrain event offers breathtaking views to match the hills runners must climb to enjoy them. Our correspondent PETER HARVEY writes: "Ten GCRs tackled the most undulating course in Hertfordshire with super views across the end of the Chiltern Hills.

In the marathon distance, LORENZO FRANCHI, despite going slightly awry and running an extra three miles, completed the course in 4:56:06. The dynamic duo of ELAINE GILES and KATH EVANS finished in 6.22.47 which, given the heat, was a super effort. CHARLOTTE JONES timed exactly 7 hours in an inspiring run epitomising endurance, fortitude and tenacity.

In the half marathon, ALEX YATES and TIM COOKE came in together at 2.20.01, and KAREN and NICK ATKINSON likewise crossed the line together in 2:34:29.

In the 10k PETER HARVEY came 2nd in 43.46 out of 144 finishers. He arrived only two minutes before the start, dumped his bike, changed, sneaked through the field to the front and acquired a number from Races Online. He was down for the marathon but did not feel well, overslept and cycled up at speed from Welwyn Garden City. The first

three finishers were all over 50 years old! Also finishing for GCR was RUSSELL DEVITT in 1:06:03. The event was a big success and well worth doing."

Needles Half Marathon

MICHAEL TANDY was in action off England's South Coast, where he ran Needles half marathon on the Isle of Wight today. Tackling a course that featured 389m of elevation gain with beach and cliff sections, Michael was pleased to finish in 1:55, 91st out of 354 runners. *Below: runners on the Needles half marathon course*

Becca writes: "Undeterred by our inability to run, we decided to walk the route. It was a stunning course and we enjoyed the atmosphere and the friendliness of the marshals. Walking off road through the scenic woodland and along the beach made it all worthwhile. We would definitely recommend the event!" Mother and daughter

(pictured left, with their medals) completed the undulating "walk" in 1hour 43 mins, definitely not a pb for either, but, Becca reminds us, "it's the taking part that counts and we enjoyed every minute."

Blenheim Palace Triathlon

GCR's ELEANOR NEWTON competed in the Blenheim Palace spring distance Triathlon on Saturday 1st June.



Eleanor (pictured left with bling, enjoying a post-race lolly) faced tough conditions with a 400m incline from the swim exit to the transition area and 28 degrees heat, as her wave set off at 1.20pm. However, Eleanor reports that "it was a stunning course and thoroughly enjoyable." Eleanor finished in 1:35:30, which put her 16th out of 162 competitors in her age group and the top 8% of all women.
