GCRs vets double silver at Stevenage

Stevenage Half Marathon

A number of GCRs completed the Stevenage half marathon on Sunday, where both the ladies and mens vets teams took home silver medals.

The event, hosted by Fairlands Valley Spartans, starts and finishes with a lap around Ridlins Running track. In between runners do a two-lap circuit around the underpasses of Stevenage, the A602 and Fairlands Valley Park. Rebecca Barden reports that "the event was well organised with friendly and encouraging marshal support. The weather was kind to us too, with yesterday's stormy conditions replaced with a cool, bright start and the rain more or less held off until the finish."

A GCR ladies team of REBECCA BARDEN, ALEX YATES and KAREN ATKINSON, and mens team of SEAN BOWEN, STEVE ELLERD-ELLIOTT, PAUL GATENS and LORENZO FRANCHI both won silver in the Herts County Vets Championship.

Becca describes the event as "a very well organised run, with reflective signage and supportive marshals through the route. After a full day of rain it was very muddy and wet but thoroughly enjoyable! Even running through a field of cows being told to 'watch out for them'!"

Becca finished first lady in a time of 0.33.08, and is pictured with her finishers medal.

DAVID HEAL ran this 6 hour trail event at the Forest Centre, Marston Montaine near Bedford. David completed 6 laps around the lake, which he reports as being a "very boggy trail circuit with lots of puddles to dodge".



Dave adds – "I was really pleased to finish the marathon distance today, first in a month as I've been out of running to deal with family emotional stress... a picturesque circuit around the lake, brilliantly organised and marshalled, with a fantastic medal presented at the finish along with a generous goody bag and bottle of Budweiser to celebrate!"

Dave completed the run, his 42nd marathon, in 05:39:27.
