#### **St Albans Easter 10K**

With Championship and Avery points up for grabs, GCRs were out in force on Good Friday for this fast and flat(ish) 10K which starts from Highfield Park, and follows an out and back route along the Alban Way with a Sleapshyde loop adding interest. First over the line for GCR was **Peter Harvey** in a new 10K pb of 36:52 and also winning his category MV50. Next was **Daniel Pudner** in 38:42, followed by **James McGeehan** in 39:12 and **Steve Ellerd-Elliott**, also running a new 10K pb of 39:28. First for GCR ladies was **Zoe Stephens** in 45:41, with **Helen Stafford**, also ringing the celebratory pb bell, not far behind in 46:27. Next for GCR ladies and also running a pb was **Sophie Packman** in 48:38.

GCR super vet **Anne Henson** ran the marathon distance with her son **Michael**, [pictured left] finishing in a fantastic sub-five hour time of 4:58:46, and winning silver in her age category V60. **Martha Hall** ran the half marathon distance and was third female overall and first in her age category V40 in a time of 1:26:32.

# parkrun roundup: 16 April

The Easter holiday and spring sunshine saw many GCRs take on parkruns across Hertforshire and beyond. A contingent of GCRs headed to Rickmansworth, from where **John McDowall** sent this report: "A thirty minute trip to Rickmansworth parkrun for a car load of GCRs, all on the recommendation of a nice fast course. **Richard Somerset** had ran three sub 20 PRs on the trot and was snuffling about for a fourth one. John McDowall sniffed the chance of a sub 21 5K. **Johan Preis** and his good wife **Alida** came along too, and as it was Johan's birthday he was already having a good day. It was certainly a great location, with the course taking in two laps round the traditional parkrun lake, pan flat and a very nice cafe with plentiful outdoor seating for afterwards, which was a boon on a glorious early summers day. We spotted two other GCRs, **Michael** and **Joanne Grant**, also engaging in a spot of parkrun tourism.

"The Badger was first home in 11th place, with the sub 20 target achieved in an impressive 18.54. John giraffed round in his sub 21 target and a parkrun PB of 20.57 in 31<sup>st</sup> place. The birthday boy Johan also ran a parkrun PB in an impressive 21.25 (41st), and Michael and Joanne were next GCRs home in 63rd and 139th in 22.46 and 26.11 respectively. Alida was 248th in 30.27, managing a very spirited sprint into the funnel at the end as her legs loosened up after a long run on the Saturday.

"Afterwards we retired to the cafe for some well-deserved coffee and some of Richard's lemon drizzle cake which I can report was firm, held together well and was mostly certainly not soggy bottomed."

Another parkrun tourist, **Rob Jones**, sent this report from Haldon Forest parkrun in Devon: "Two intrepid GCRs, Rob Jones and **Brad Smith**, headed to Haldon Forest from their separate holiday

digs this morning. They were greeted with a well-presented Forestry Commission woodland, high above the Exe Valley. Misty views prevented any views from the clearings, but the light and mist presented a very atmospheric surrounding. Two loops - one 2k, the other 3k were punctuated by two hills to make Heartbreak Hill and Cardiac Hill in Tewin seem tame by comparison. This is an excellent parkrun with a top coffee shop afterwards. Well recommended." Also on their travels in Devon were **Wayne Aylott** and **Tom Rogers**, who ran the UK's second most challenging parkrun at Woolacombe Dunes.
