Wheathampsted 10k

It was the usual scenic and 'undulating' route out from Marford playing fields up the Ayot Green Way, before looping back, via the hills, fields and lovely views across the Lea Valley. The sun shone throughout, which would have been lovely for the family fun back at base, but a source of much griping from the runners! **Dave Edwards** led the GCRs home in 51:02, followed by **Elaine Moore** 53:45, **Maggie Wright** 58:20, **Richard Brown** 1:02:11, **Charlotte Jones** 1:21:56, **Jane Molloy** 1:22:38, and **Samantha Hastie** 1:24:08. The queue for the ice cream van at the end was mercifully short. Having to retire early with an injury, **Jacqueline McCallum** returned to start to cheer home the finishers and to help **Sue Fletcher** dish out Welwyn 10k flyers.

London Greenways Challenge: Celandine Route

As part of their London Greenways Challenge, which involves running a different route in London every month, **Ann Hayden and Barbara Kubis-Labiak** ventured to Pinner, to start *The Celandine Route*.

Barbara reports: "The route itself stretches for 12 miles from Pinner, along the River Pinn, and finishes in Cowley on the Grand Union Canal. It's almost hidden and it was easy to forget that we were in London while running. So many green spaces, conservation areas and wildlife. The route passes through Eastcote House Gardens, Hillingdon House Farm and Dowding Park, ending near Uxbridge."



Ann reports: "The Celandine Route did not disappoint with plenty of beautiful off road through West London incorporating woods and meadows along the river Pinn. The clouds cleared and the sun shone as we made our way from Pinner south towards Yiewsley. Great company, great weather and a great route made for a Super Saturday."

Hertfordshire Triathlon 2022

James Dunmore, **Richard Robinson** and **Spencer White** all participated in this year's Hertfordshire Triathon which was based at Stanborough Lakes.



Spencer (*pictured left*) managed to knock 8 minutes off his overall time from last year's event which he was thrilled about. Spencer's overall time of 2:37:55 put him 55th overall and 16th in his age category

James reports, "fabulous weather for it, and the lake was a tropical 17 degrees. Two laps of the lake (1.5k), and then onto a 2-lap loop to Wheathampsted totalling 38k. Then four 2.5km "S" laps of the South Lake for the 10k. Great event, (I) really enjoyed it, very well run. It has been a goal of mine to do this since 2012 when I watched the Brownlee brothers at the London Olympics. I didn't quite match their times though!" James finished in 2:43.21, beating his 2:45 target, with 35min swim, 1hr 20min cycle and a 43min 10k (with MWL legs!).

Richard reports, "great early conditions for the swim and the bike made way for a very sunny and warm run. Some great performances out there and we both finished in 2hrs 44 mins with James just a smidgeon ahead after a great run. Really good event and so much fun to take part in. If anyone is thinking of taking on the challenge of triathlon I can 100% recommend it."

parkrun roundup: 21 May

Ten GCRs made an early start from WGC, travelling by overground, underground, Docklands Light Railway and on foot to Victoria Dock parkrun in London's Docklands. The parkrun, reputed to be one of the fastest in the country, takes in two laps of an out and back by the water's edge. Group leader **Richard 'Badger' Somerset** was the first GCR home, finishing in fifth place in 19:09 and second-highest age grading. Only two seconds behind was **Steve Ellerd-Elliott** in 19:11, followed by **Peter Jasko** in 21:43, **Rebecca Barden** in 22:42 and second lady, **Caroline Griffin** in 24:35, **Anna Lillie** in 24:52, **Kath Evans** in 29:51 and **Willow Gibson** in 34:13. The group cooled down after their effort with a stroll to a nearby cafe for coffee and croissants, enjoyed in the sunshine with accompanying inquisitive pigeons.



Elsewhere, GCRs were out in force throughout the land. **Martha Hall** was first lady at Panshanger in 21:11, where **Rob Casserley** and **Chris Eland** placed fourth and sixth respectively. **Sanjeev Kaushal** picked up yet another PB as did **Elaine Moore** and **Henry Bostock**.
