#### **Becca Bags Bedford Ultra Gold**

Our ultra-running ace **Becca Hayden** was in action at the 321 6 hour ultra around Marston Moretaine in Bedford. Becca reports: "It was a pretty flat route which led me to go out a bit too fast. However, weather conditions were perfect and soon I was clocking up the miles. I managed to do the marathon distance in 3 hours 50 minutes, and then chose to slow down a bit for the last few laps as I was worried about getting injured. My legs were becoming increasingly stiff! The route was scenic and well-marked, looping around the lake and fields. The marshals were lovely and supportive and everyone was so friendly and welcoming, which is one thing that I have really noticed at ultras, what a great atmosphere there is. I finished running just over 35 miles in a time of 5

## Preis on fire as GCRs tackle Lee Valley Run Fest

A small cohort of GCRs set off early on a chilly Sunday morning, travelling southwards to take

part in the Lee Valley 10K and Half Marathon, both events starting and finishing at the White Water Centre and following a flat course around the park. There were strong performances over both distances: in the 10K, all four GCRs ran in under the hour. **Ali Riza Eroglu** was first home in 48:38, 3<sup>rd</sup> in his age group V60; **Karen Atkinson** finished in 57:08 and was 2<sup>nd</sup> V60; **Carol Reid** ran in 58:36, and **Shena Lancaster** was 4<sup>th</sup> V60 in 59:21. In the half, **Johan Preis** smashed his previous half pb by over eight minutes to finish in 1:36:23 and fifth in his age group V50. **Lee Wood** also ran a pb in the half distance, in 1:48:33 – Lee reports that it was unexpected as he's still recovering from a bout of Covid. Also in action were **Thomas Parmley**, running in 2:05:07 and **David Selwood** in 2:14:22.

#### GCRs bring home gold at Herts Vets XC



A contingent of our wellmatured members represented GCR at the Herts County Vets cross country meet up at Trent Park on Sunday. GCR teams delivered an outstanding performance - Bruce Judge, Peter Harvey, Richard Somerset and Lee Mansfield won the MV50 team gold and Bruce was third MV50. Stuart Mann was second in the MV70 race.

Meanwhile, the slightly younger **Chris Eland**, **Paul Guy**, **Andrzej Gasiorowski** and **Herbie Hopkins** scored a silver in the MV40 competition. In the women's race, **Martha Hall** was first V45, **Veronica Shadbolt** was second FV55, and the women's team including **Yvonne Jones** were first FV45 team. Well done all!
