Welwyn 10K crowns a hat trick of successes at Panshanger Park

If any doubts remained of Welwyn 10K's successful relocation from the roads surrounding Singler's Marsh in Old Welwyn to the beautiful trails of Panshanger Park three years ago, then they were surely dispelled by the 2025 edition. Once again this weekend's race was superbly organised by Garden City Runners under the direction of RD, **Barbara Kubis-Labiak.**

Like any successful formula the event is constantly under review, and this year's new start location—at the gate on Panshanger Lane—streamlined the event still further.

Barbara was backed up by her race team and a huge number of volunteers (and the support of the weather ... which was mercifully a few degrees shy of the recent heatwave). The 450 or so participants certainly appreciated the light breeze and the race started on time, with a 'ready, steady, go' by **Lynn Chesterman OBE**, the Mayor of Welwyn Hatfield.

Reflecting on the race (which also included a 2K race for children), Barbara said that after all the behind-the-scenes prep, with Zoom calls and last minute adjustments, "and all of a sudden the field in Panshanger Park turned into a bustling, happy gathering of volunteers, runners, walkers, families, children and spectators."

The Race Director reserved special thanks for an army of volunteers, without whom the event wouldn't have been so memorable. "They were amazing," she said. "The parking team, organised by **Rab Harley** and **Andy Sturgess**, included **Mark Harley, Patrick Millar, Brenda Smith, Pat Harley, Alison Paterson, Michael Scutt,** and **Sam Plummer**. Nadine writes: "This weekend, Phoenix Running hosted their Denbies Festival of Running and well, it was brutal! I thought I had signed up for scenic loops around the Denbies Wine Estate but accidentally seemed to have entered some sort of sauna endurance experiment instead.

Boiling hot, zero shade and the heat was just relentless. Tough going but got it done and it's another marathon ticked off! Went super slow and had lots and lots of breaks - handy when you're on a 1-mile loop through the vineyards. Iced water bottles, a cold water bucket and the hose pipe were a godsend. I got up close and personal with that water hose more often than I can disclose and pretty much ended up having full on showers after most laps. Of course there was the odd ice lolly as well.

It was lovely seeing so many familiar faces and the support and encouragement was just brilliant. And as always, we were well looked after by the Phoenix team. The highlight of the day was buddying up with a guy I met on the day. We ended up plodding and basically raving around the last 8 or more laps together...great tunes and great company...almost made the last bit seem like a breeze. As well as the usual half and full marathon options, many runners were also going for various ultra distances. Huge respect to everyone who turned up on Saturday and ran in pretty brutal conditions."

The group runs are planned to take approximately an hour, the following table gives an idea of the pace. To give variety, especially in the summer, distances will vary a little. Those attending by car are asked to **park in the school car park (Herns Lane)** and not the Sports Centre car park (Appletree Way).

Interval Sessions: Tuesdays 6:45pm start, various locations in Welwyn Garden City

Approximately 25 mins of high intensity intervals over distances from 400m to a mile, with rest periods, in various locations in WGC. Runners of all abilities are welcome, pace is dictated by the runners themselves, slower runners will simply do fewer repetitions. Members will be notified of the locations and session format on email and Facebook.

Group Runs – Thursdays 6:20pm for 6.30pm start, Campus West

Thursday group run meets at Campus West on the steps outside the library. The What3Words location for the start is for start location: <u>https://w3w.co/**eager.bliss.stuff**</u>. There are usually three groups as follows:
